The LDA Management is committed to leading and supporting the occupational safety and health management system, ensuring that resources are provided for its implementation, maintenance and continuous improvement.

Our occupational safety and health policy is based on the following

PRINCIPLES:

Compliance: Comply with all legal, regulatory, sectoral and contractual obligations that affect safety and health at work

Prevention first and foremost: Systematically identify and assess the hazards associated with our activities and take the necessary measures to eliminate them and reduce the risks to the lowest possible level.

Consultation and participation: Encourage the active participation of workers and their representatives at all levels of the occupational safety and health management system, through the occupational safety and health committee and established communication channels.

Awareness and Training: Raising awareness of hazards and risks at work, as well as knowledge and application of practices and procedures to eliminate or reduce them.

Continuous improvement: Periodically review the system to assess its effectiveness and improve its performance and adaptation to changing requirements and other factors.

This policy will be reviewed periodically by the LDA Management.
