

Declaration on Compliance with REACH and Related European Chemical Substance Regulations

This declaration is issued under the sole responsibility of the manufacturer LDA Audio Tech S.L. Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) establishes requirements intended to ensure a high level of protection of human health and the environment while enhancing the free movement of substances within the European Economic Area.

LDA Audio Tech designs, manufactures and markets electronic equipment and systems for voice alarm, public address, emergency communication and related applications.

The products supplied by LDA Audio Tech are articles within the meaning of Article 3 of the REACH Regulation and are therefore not subject to the registration requirements applicable to chemical substances as such or in mixtures.

As a downstream user and manufacturer of articles, LDA Audio Tech has established procedures to ensure compliance with the applicable requirements of the REACH Regulation throughout its supply chain. In particular, LDA Audio Tech:

- monitors updates published by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA), including the Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC);
- requires its suppliers to provide information regarding REACH compliance and the presence of SVHCs where applicable;
- ensures compliance with the restrictions laid down in Annex XVII of the REACH Regulation;
- fulfils the communication obligations established in Article 33 whenever applicable.

As part of its product compliance management system, LDA Audio Tech also monitors compliance with other applicable European legislation governing hazardous and restricted substances in products, including, where applicable:

- Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 on Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs);
- Regulation (EU) 2017/852 on Mercury;
- Regulation (EC) No. 1005/2009 on substances that deplete the ozone layer.

Compliance with these regulations is managed through supplier qualification, material compliance verification and internal product compliance procedures.

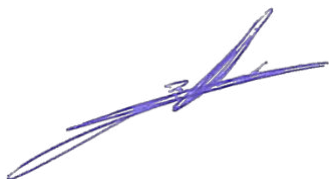
Based on the information currently available from our suppliers and our internal compliance processes, LDA Audio Tech declares that its products comply with the applicable requirements of Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH).

Where a product contains a Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) included in the Candidate List at a concentration above 0.1% (w/w) in any article, the information required by Article 33 of the REACH Regulation will be provided to customers upon request or through specific product documentation, as applicable.

This declaration is based on information received from our suppliers together with LDA Audio Tech's internal compliance procedures and is valid according to the Candidate List published by ECHA on the date of issue of this declaration.
